- Individuals and families interested in becoming a Shared Living Home participate in an initial licensure process overseen by the DDS and facilitated by Benhaven staff.
- Once a license is generated from the DDS, the process of an individual and Shared Living Home family members getting to know each other commences. Visits overseen by the Benhaven Shared Living Program Coordinator are arranged to accommodate both the individual and Shared Living Home Provider. These visits continue until both the individual with intellectual disabilities and the Shared Living Home Provider decide they would like to live together.
- Monitoring by the Benhaven Shared Living coordinator will occur at least monthly and when needed, to ensure the continued success of both the individual with intellectual disabilities and the Shared Living Home provider and family.
- Annually, the Shared Living Home provider will experience the annual license renewal process, with assistance from the Benhaven Shared Living coordinator.
